Misha Cohen graduated from San Francisco College of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine, and is the Clinical Director of Chicken Soup Chinese Medicine, Executive Director of the MRCE Foundation, Research Chairperson of Quan Yin Healing Arts Center, and Research Specialist of Integrative Medicine at the University of California Institute for Health and Aging, all in San Francisco, CA. She is also an elected Fellow to the National Academy of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine. She has been practicing traditional Asian medicine for the past 33 years.

For more than twenty years, Dr. Cohen has developed Chinese traditional medicine treatment protocols for HIV/AIDS, hepatitis, PMS, infertility, endometriosis, HPV-related diseases and menopausal syndromes. She has written numerous articles, appeared on national radio and TV, and has published several books on the topics of HIV, hepatitis and other subjects. Dr. Cohen is recognized internationally as a senior teacher and leading expert in Chinese traditional medicine. She was invited several times by the Chinese government to present her programs, and her articles on HIV/AIDS have been officially translated for use in China.

The Hepatitis C Help Program: East/West Approaches to HVC and Prevention of Liver Cancer

All contemporary healthcare practitioners must understand the threat of hepatitis C. Misha Ruth Cohen outlines the *Hepatitis C Help Program* of Traditional Chinese Medicine and natural therapies, and reviews TCM diagnosis, acupuncture treatment, and East/West programs. Dr. Cohen provides an overview of the current state of HCV research, Western diagnostic and lab tests, and approaches to HCV treatment. She addresses key issues of virology, epidemiology, and prevention, and important aspects of prevention of liver cancer associated with chronic hepatitis C.

Dr. Cohen brings extensive experience and research to bear in introducing participants to virology and cancer, and TCM's approach to viral-related cancers, as well as her wealth of experience and insight in preventing and treating HCV and its complications, including the use of herbs, acupuncture and moxibustion.

The HIV Wellness Program: Focus on Chinese Medicine

Has human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) moved into the "chronic, treatable" category of disease, or is this formidable killer still on the rampage? Misha Ruth Cohen outlines the *HIV Wellness Program*, using primarily Traditional Chinese Medicine and natural therapies in conjunction with Western medicine for treatment of those with HIV. Dr. Cohen reviews the immune system in HIV from a Chinese medicine perspective, incorporating TCM diagnosis, acupuncture and moxibustion protocols used since the early 1980s for thousands of people.

Dr. Cohen leads participants in review of some of the herbal research that has been performed in people with HIV and discusses its significance to the Chinese medicine world. In closing there will be an interactive discussion of development of comprehensive treatment plans for people with HIV.




